





Typical Light Duty Vari-Speed Drive Mounting on 6100/6200 Series Conveyor









6100/6200 Series Conveyor Typical Mountings Figure 3

1. Place 1st T-bar (Figure 8, item G) into T-slot, insert screw (D) into hole in lower mounting tab and, using a 4 mm hex key wrench, partially thread into T-bar.




NOTE

For electrical wiring or troubleshooting, refer to information provided by manufacturer. 2. Raise controller to its approximate mounting position and tighten screw (Figure 9, item D) to temporarily fix the controller position. Then, insert 2nd T-bar (G) into T-slot as shown.





3. Using screwdriver (Figure 10, item L), raise 2nd T-bar to align it with upper mounting tab hole and insert a screw (D) and partially thread into T-bar as shown. Then position controller to desired location and tightly secure both screws (D).



Steel Stand Leg

1. Attach to steel stand leg using spring nuts (Figure 11, item F), washers (E) and screws (C).





Notes

Return Policy

Returns must have prior written factory authorization or they will not be accepted. Items that are returned to Dorner without authorization will not be credited nor returned to the original sender. When calling for authorization, please have the following information ready for the Dorner factory representative or your local distributor:

- 1. Name and address of customer.
- 2. Dorner part number(s) of item(s) being returned.
- 3. Reason for return.
- 4. Customer's original order number used when ordering the item(s).
- 5. Dorner or distributor invoice number (if available, part serial number).

A representative will discuss action to be taken on the returned items and provide a Returned Goods Authorization (RMA) number for reference. RMA will automatically close 30 days after being issued. To get credit, items must be new and undamaged. There will be a return charge on all items returned for credit, where Dorner was not at fault. It is the customer's responsibility to prevent damage during return shipping. Damaged or modified items will not be accepted. The customer is responsible for return freight.
