2100/3100 Series or LPZ Conveyor Mounting

Mount the motor starter to the conveyor T-slot as shown (Figure 1 or 2).





6100 Series Conveyor Mounting

Mount the motor starter to the bottom edge of the conveyor as shown (Figure 3 or 4).





Conveyor Stand Mounting

Attach the motor starter to the aluminum stand leg or single post support stand using the two (2) smaller M6 spring nuts (B) as shown (Figure 5). The starter may be attached to the steel stand leg using the two (2) larger M6 spring nuts (F) as shown (Figure 6).





NOTE: The mounting hole center-line to center-line dimensions (Figure 7) are provided for control panel mounting.



Wiring



WARNING



To prevent injury, make sure all electrical power sources have been disconnected before you perform any maintenance or adjustments or replace any components.

The 230 and the 400 volts three-phase manual motor starters must be wired, in accordance with applicable local electrical codes. The proper three-phase motor shaft rotation is achieved when the line phase sequence L1, L2 & L3 is connected to the terminals as shown in Figure 8.

Attach the ground wire to the lower left terminal marked $\frac{\perp}{=}$.

NOTE: The motor ground wire will also be attached to this same lower left terminal marked $\frac{1}{2}$.



WARNING



To prevent injury from electrocution, make sure this ground connection is solidly made and continuity-tested, before any electrical power is first applied.


