In addition, pursuant to the March 24 executive order issued by Governor Tony Evers, Dorner qualifies as an essential business. As a result, Dorner will retain our manufacturing operations, located in Hartland, WI, and all field related support in the United States, through this crisis.

Our decision to remain open is supported by multiple letters from key customers who have already been deemed essential and require Dorner to continue operations as an *essential* supplier to their ability to maintain their business operations.
